

Ingredients:

8 ounces low-fat vanilla yogurt
2 tablespoons 100% orange juice
1 tablespoon lime juice
2 apples, cored and sliced
1 pear, cored and sliced
1 medium plum, sliced
8 large strawberries



Feel free to use your favorite seasonal fruits.

Directions:

1. Wash hands with warm water and soap. Wash fruits with water before preparing.
2. In a small bowl, combine yogurt, orange juice, lime juice; mix well.
3. Serve dip in a bowl on a large plate and surround with sliced fruit.
