Food Insecurity Nutrition Incentive (FINI)	Arizona was awarded the FINI grant through Pinnacle Prevention. Activities will take place in Yavapai, Maricopa, and Pima counties. Activities planned for farmer's markets and a CSA demonstration project. Formal announcement to come at the end of this month.
	Project is called Double Up Food Bucks AZ. Project will match up to \$10 per day per participant. Participant must purchase SNAP eligible foods and the \$10 match will go towards locally grown produce.
