FY2026 Curriculum List

For FY2026, the curriculum outlined in this resource reflects the selections made by Local Agencies within their project proposals. These curricula come from the Arizona SNAP-Ed FY26–FY30 Approved Curriculum List and represent evidence-based, fidelity-aligned approaches that strengthen community-driven policy, systems, and environmental (PSE) initiatives. To streamline reporting and reduce burden on partners, data collection this year will focus specifically on adult and senior preferred curricula and associated reach.

This targeted approach supports the direction of the Arizona SNAP-Ed Carryforward Funding Overview, which emphasizes aligning direct education with broader community change strategies, prioritizing trauma-informed methods, and deepening connections between nutrition education and PSE improvements. By centering evaluation on adult and senior programming, the State SNAP-Ed Teams are able to gather meaningful outcome data while ensuring that Local Agencies can dedicate more time to high-impact, community-responsive work across Arizona.
